SYNOPSIS —

The following traffic regulation change has been reviewed by staff and is recommended for approval:
Request for Corner Clearance: East Side of East Twenty-sixth Street south of East Madison Avenue.

FISCAL IMPACT —

RECOMMENDATION —

Refer to Legal Department for preparation of ordinance revisions.

BACKGROUND —

The Office of Traffic and Transportation received a request from the Public Works Department for a corner clearance on the east side of East Twenty-sixth south of Madison Avenue in order to facilitate turning movements for solid waste and recyclable materials removal trucks. The following revision to the Municipal Code will effect this change.

SEC. 27-1807. EAST TWENTY-SIXTH STREET--EAST COURT AVENUE TO EAST MADISON AVENUE.

East Twenty-sixth Street, on the east side, from East Madison Avenue to a point 45 feet south thereof, no parking any time.
