SYNOPSIS —

Staff has revised the existing 28E agreement between the City of Des Moines and the State of Iowa for the use of State Capitol property for summer music concerts. The State requested the agreement include the Des Moines Symphony's, July 4th, Yankee Doodle Pops Concert, the Des Moines Children's Chorus concerts on Memorial Day weekend, and similar types of free concerts where the residents of Des Moines will benefit from the opportunity. The State now grants the City certain concession rights during all concerts as a way for the City to help recover some of the costs associated with the Music Under the Stars series.

FISCAL IMPACT —

This 28E agreement will formalize the concession arrangements the City has had with the State for the past four years which annually provides approximately \$1,500 in net revenue.

RECOMMENDATION —

Approval of the 28E Agreement with the State of Iowa.

BACKGROUND —

On April 8, 1997, by Resolution No. 97-128, the Des Moines Park and Recreation Board approved the amendment to the 28E Agreement. This agreement will replace and supersede the amended 28E cultural agreement dated May 17, 1993. It allows the City to conduct free summer music concerts on the State of Iowa property at the Iowa State Capitol complex. The agreement will continue indefinitely until terminated or amended.
