SYNOPSIS —

The following traffic regulation changes have been reviewed by staff and is recommended for approval:

- A. Request from Executive Director Kathleen Moretz, Neighborhood Housing Services of Des Moines, Inc., for handicapped parking in front of 1153 24th Street.

RECOMMENDATION —

Refer to Legal Department for preparation of ordinance revisions.

BACKGROUND —

- A. The Traffic and Transportation Division received a request from Kathleen Moretz, Executive Director of Neighborhood Housing Services of Des Moines, Inc., for a handicapped parking space in front of her office located at 1153 - 24th Street. The Traffic and Transportation Division concurred with Ms. Moretz's request and forwarded her letter to Fred Wegner, Chair, Access Advisory Board, for recommendation. Since Mr. Wegner has approved our recommendation for placement of a handicapped space, the following revision to the Municipal Code is necessary to effect the change:

SEC. 27-1793--TWENTY-FOURTH STREET--INGERSOLL AVENUE TO BENNETT AVENUE.

Twenty-fourth Street, on the east side, from a point 50 feet south of University Avenue to a point ~~210~~ 220 feet south thereof, two hour parking, 9:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m.

Twenty-fourth Street, on the east side, from a point 270 feet of University Avenue to a point 293 feet south thereof, is designated a handicapped parking space and is subject to the same prohibition as is found in Section 27-616(a) of this Code.
