BACKGROUND—

The Des Moines Municipal Housing Agency submits their 5-Year PHA Plan (2000 – 2004) and an Annual PHA Plan (2004) to the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) each year to show the programs and activities that will be pursued for the upcoming program

year. These activities are directed to further the goals of HUD to support decent, safe, and affordable housing; improve community quality of life and economic vitality; promote self-sufficiency and asset development of families and individuals, and to ensure equal opportunity in housing for all Americans. The Des Moines PHA Five-Year goals include the “Development of Affordable Housing,” “Increase Assisted Housing Choices,” and “Promote Self-Sufficiency.”

All of the goals and the supporting activities to implement them are consistent with the current goals of the 2000 – 2004 Consolidated Plan to “Increase the availability of affordable rental and homeownership opportunities for low and moderate income residents.”
