SUBJECT—

Resolution Giving Preliminary Approval for a Neighborhood Commercial Revitalization (NCR) Program Loan in the amount of \$65,000 for renovations to 412, 414 and 416 East Fifth Street, Des Moines.

SYNOPSIS—

This action provides preliminary approval for a \$65,000 Neighborhood Commercial Revitalization (NCR) Program Loan to Robert Eikleberry. The Developer is improving the commercial buildings located at 412, 414 and 416 East Fifth Street in accordance with the East Village Design Guideline Recommendations. The improvement costs are estimated at about \$130,000, and will address the buildings' structural deterioration with facade replacement, tuck-pointing, brick and roof replacement and upgrading of electrical and plumbing services. The properties are located in the East Village Study Block.

FISCAL IMPACT—

The \$65,000 Neighborhood Commercial Revitalization (NCR) Loan will be funded from the Eastern Gateway Project Account. The proposed loan would be repaid with three percent (3%) interest over a term of fifteen years and secured by a first real estate mortgage on 416 East Fifth Street, Des Moines.

BACKGROUND—

Robert Eikleberry has owned and operated the Blazing Saddle located at 416 E. Fifth Street since 1983. He purchased the commercial buildings located at 412 and 414 East Fifth Street in the year 2000. The Blazing Saddle now occupies both 416 and 414 East Fifth Street. The commercial building located at 412 East Fifth Street maintains two street level commercial spaces and two residential units on the upper level. Mr. Eikleberry is working with Kirk Blunk with HLKB Architecture on the improvement designs for the buildings.
