ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

Kevin Risk, (**R-1**), **Forensic Identification Technician**, to Norman, OK, from April 15 – April 21, 2012, (\$1,759), to attend the second course of a series taught by world renowned bloodstain pattern experts. The course will be another step in gaining certification in bloodstain pattern examination through the International Association for Identification.

Douglas Romig, (R-0), Housing Services Director, to Washington, DC, from February 27 – March 2, 2012, (\$2,024), to attend the National Community Action Foundation Legislative Conference to meet and coordinate Federal legislative issues regarding CSBG, LIHEAP and other Federal funding for Community Action Agencies. The conference will also provide educational sessions and national networking opportunities.

The amended budget for travel and training in Fiscal Year (FY) 2012 is \$584,905. The amount expended for travel and training in FY 2012, as of January 16, 2012, is \$205,232.
