AGENDA HEADING:

Ordering construction of the following: 2020 Sidewalk Replacement Program - Receiving bids, (2-25-20), and Setting date of hearing, (3-23-20). Construction Estimate - \$500,000.

SYNOPSIS:

Recommend the City Council proceed with construction of this improvement and set dates to receive bids and hold a public hearing, as required by Iowa Code, utilizing the method of financing referenced below. This project provides for a City-wide program to replace deteriorated City sidewalks, sidewalks damaged by City activities or by City trees in the parkway, and sidewalks for residents that qualify for the special assessment subsidy.



Amount: \$500,000 (City Engineer's Estimate)

<u>Funding Source</u>: 2019-2020 CIP, Page Street – 29, Sidewalk Replacement, SW084, being: \$200,000 G.O. Bonds issued, \$300,000 G.O Bonds to be issued

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

- The Engineering Department has prepared plans, specifications, form of contract documents, and City Engineer's estimate for the construction of the 2020 Sidewalk Replacement Program, 09-2020-003. The improvement includes reconstruction of brick sidewalks, Class A and Class B Portland Cement Concrete (PCC) sidewalks of varying thicknesses, together with all appurtenances; in accordance with the contract documents, at various City-wide locations in Des Moines, Iowa. Sidewalks will be replaced at locations inspected by the Engineering Department. Curb ramps, compliant with the requirements of the Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) of 1990 and the regulations associated with this law, as it applies to pedestrian facilities, will also be constructed in the vicinity where sidewalks will be replaced.
- The estimated construction cost is \$500,000. The proposed plans, specifications, and form of contract documents are available for public inspection in the City Engineer's Office.
