AGENDA HEADING:

Ordering construction of the following: Public Works Salt Shed Expansion - Receiving bids, (2-25-20), and Setting date of hearing, (3-9-20). Construction Estimate - \$1,380,000.

SYNOPSIS:

Recommend the City Council proceed with construction of the improvement and set dates to receive bids and hold a public hearing, as required by Iowa Code, utilizing the method of financing referenced below. The project comprises of the construction of a 12,000-ton salt storage shed to increase the existing available capacity at the Public Works yard for road salt storage

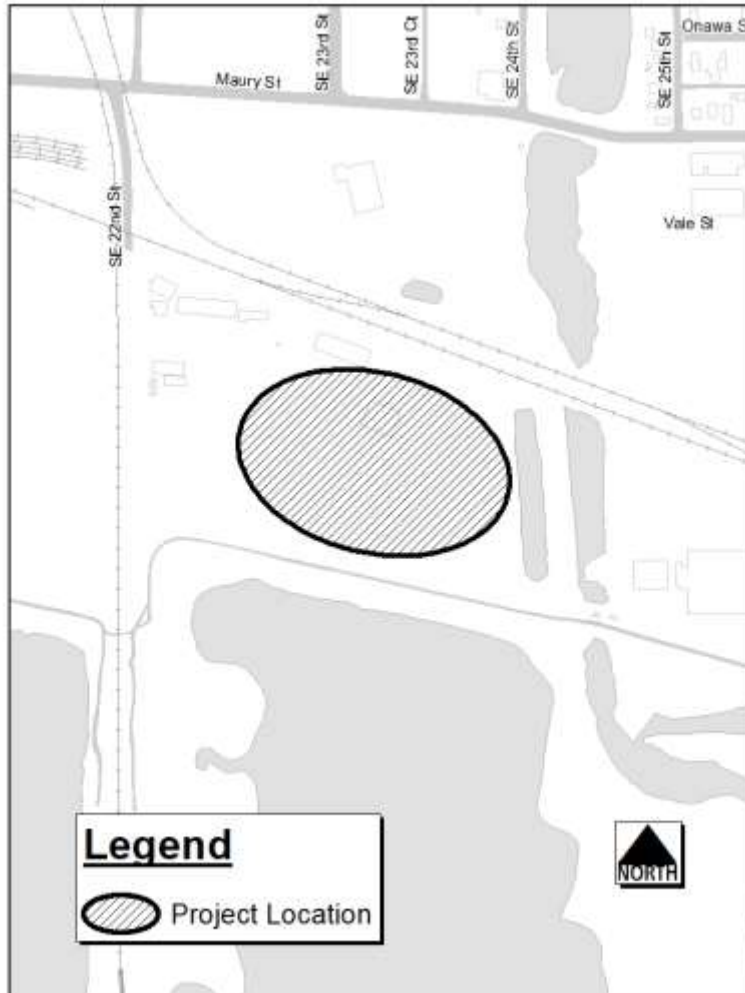
FISCAL IMPACT:

Amount: \$1,380,000 City Engineer's Estimate

Funding Source: 2019-2020 CIP, Page Building – 15, Public Works Salt Shed, BL131; Being: \$830,000 Road Use Tax, \$950,000 G.O. Bonds to be issued.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

- The Engineering Department has prepared plans, specifications, form of contract documents, and City Engineer's estimate for the construction of the Public Works Salt Shed Expansion, 10-2019-010. The improvement includes the construction of a 12,000-ton capacity, pre-engineered hoop truss salt storage building including pavement removal, grading, foundation, electrical, and Hot Mix Asphalt (HMA) pavement; all work in accordance with the contract documents, including Plan File Nos. 584-190/203, located at the Des Moines Public Works Supply Yard, 903 S.E. 22nd Street.
- The estimated construction cost is \$1,380,000. The proposed plans, specifications, and form of contract documents are available for public inspection in the Des Moines City Engineer's Office.
