
### FISCAL IMPACT:

- The Engineering Department has prepared plans, specifications, form of contract documents, and City Engineer's estimate for the construction of the Riverwalk Improvements Paver Replacement, 04-2019-004. The improvement includes removal and replacement of deteriorated sidewalk concrete unit pavers, limestone pavers, and associated work; all in accordance with the contract documents, located along the Riverwalk between Center Street and Vine Street along the west side of the Des Moines River.

  Office.
