### AGENDA HEADING:

Hearing on Hubbell Avenue Rehabilitation from E. 18th Street to Easton Boulevard: Resolution approving plans, specifications, form of contract documents, engineer's estimate, receive and file bids, and designating lowest responsible bidder as OMG Midwest, Inc. d/b/a Des Moines Asphalt & Paving, Kevin Bragg, President, \$1,605,743.

### SYNOPSIS:

This is a public hearing to allow for public input on the Hubbell Avenue Rehabilitation from E. 18th Street to Easton Boulevard and take the necessary actions as required by Iowa Code to authorize a contract for construction of the proposed project. This project includes the rehabilitation of Hubbell Avenue between E. 18th Street and Easton Boulevard including constructing missing sidewalk connections, full depth patching, milling and Hot Mix Asphalt (HMA) overlay, and storm sewer improvements north of University Avenue.

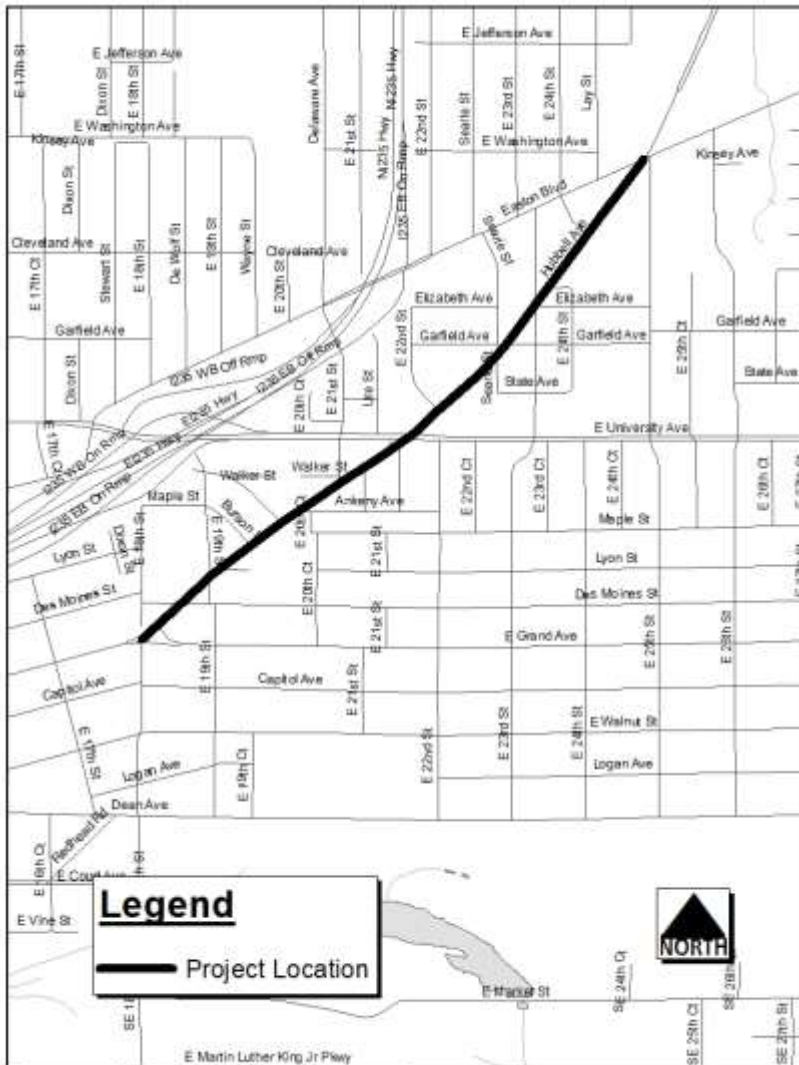

### ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

- On January 27, 2020, under Roll Call No. 20-0127, the City Council received and filed plans, specifications, form of contract documents, and City Engineer's estimate for the construction of the Hubbell Avenue Rehabilitation from E. 18th Street to Easton Boulevard. Before the City Council can enter into a contract, it must hold a public hearing and approve the proposed plans, specifications, and form of contract documents and engineer's estimate for the construction of the Hubbell Avenue Rehabilitation from E. 18th Street to Easton Boulevard, 06-2019-019. The improvement includes Portland Cement Concrete (PCC) full depth patches, curb & gutter, sidewalk, driveways, milling, HMA overlay, modified subbase, subdrain, storm sewer installation, storm sewer intakes, pavement markings, traffic control, seeding, miscellaneous associated work including cleanup and restoration; all in accordance with the contract documents, including Plan File Nos. 615-110/163, located at Hubbell Avenue between E. 18th Street and Easton Boulevard.

- Sealed bids for said improvement were submitted by the following bidders:
  - OMG Midwest, Inc. d/b/a Des Moines Asphalt & Paving, Ankeny, IA
  - Grimes Asphalt and Paving Corporation, Des Moines, IA
  - Hawkeye Paving Corporation, Bettendorf, IA
  - TK Concrete, Inc., Pella, IA
  - Jasper Construction Services, Inc., Newton, IA
- The bids were received and opened at a public meeting presided over by the Engineer in the City Council Chambers, 2nd Floor, City Hall, 400 Robert D. Ray Drive, Des Moines, Iowa at 11:00 a.m. on February 11, 2020.
- The City Engineer has determined that the lowest responsive, responsible bid for the construction of said improvement was submitted by Des Moines Asphalt & Paving (Kevin Bragg, President, 2401 SE Tones Drive, Suite. 13, Ankeny, IA, 50021), in the amount of \$1,605,743.00, and said bid should be accepted. The Finance Director has determined that funds are available for said improvement as stated above.
