AGENDA HEADING:

Hearing on 2020 Traffic Signal Replacement Contract 1: Resolution approving plans, specifications, form of contract documents, engineer's estimate, receive and file bids, and designating lowest responsible bidder as Van Maanen Electric, Inc., Nathan S. Van Maanen, President, \$831,245.

SYNOPSIS:

This is a public hearing to allow for public input on the 2020 Traffic Signal Replacement Contract 1 and take the necessary actions as required by Iowa Code to authorize a contract for construction of the proposed project. The project includes replacement of traffic signals at the intersections of S.E. 5th Street and E. Porter Avenue and E. 30th Street and E. Walnut Street, and a new High-Intensity Activated CrossWalk (HAWK) signal near Mercy College on 6th Avenue north of Crocker Street.



ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

• On February 10, 2020, under Roll Call No. 20-0209, the City Council received and filed plans, specifications, form of contract documents, and City Engineer's estimate for the construction of the 2020 Traffic Signal Replacement Contract 1. Before the City Council can enter into a contract, it must hold a public hearing and approve the proposed plans, specifications, and form of contract documents and engineer's estimate for the construction of the 2020 Traffic Signal Replacement Contract 1, 04-2020-007. The improvement includes new traffic signals, new High-Intensity Activated CrossWalk (HAWK) pedestrian signal, vehicle loop detectors, Hot Mix Asphalt (HMA) pavement, Portland Cement Concrete (PCC) sidewalk, pavement markings, and other incidental items; all in accordance with the contract documents, including Plan File Nos. 613-128/187, located at the intersections of S.E. 5th Street and E. Porter Avenue and of E. 30th Street and E. Walnut Street, and near Mercy College on 6th Avenue north of Crocker Street.

- Sealed bids for said improvement were submitted by the following bidders:

- The bids were received and opened at a public meeting presided over by the Engineer in the City Council Chambers, 2nd Floor, City Hall, 400 Robert D. Ray Drive, Des Moines, Iowa at 11:00 a.m. on February 25, 2020.
- The City Engineer has determined that the lowest responsive, responsible bid for the construction of said improvement was submitted by Van Maanen Electric, Inc., Nathan S. Van Maanen, President, 500 Iowa Speedway, Newton, IA, 50208 in the amount of \$831,245, and said bid should be accepted. The Finance Director has determined that funds are available for said improvement as stated above.
