

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

- On April 9, 2018, under Roll Call No. 18-0634, the City Council approved plans and specifications and designated the lowest responsible bidder as S.M. Hentges & Sons, Inc. for \$2,754,041.28. This Phase 2 project will improve storm water drainage along Vandalia Road, provide storm sewer access to the Regional Detention Basin for future Agrimergent Technology Park development, and provide a storm water outlet pipe for the future Southeast Connector project from S.E. 30th to Highway 65.
- Change Order No. 1 approved by the City Engineer on January 29, 2020, for a total amount of \$40,453.39, included addition of storm sewer at 3950 Vandalia Road, storm sewer boring modifications, and water main night work.
- Change Order No. 2 includes adjustment of contract quantities and removal and replacement of driveway pavement at multiple locations along Vandalia Road to improve access management.
