### AGENDA HEADING:

Hearing on Martin Luther King Jr. Parkway Rehabilitation from Hickman Road to Euclid Avenue: Resolution approving plans, specifications, form of contract documents, engineer's estimate, receive and file bids, and designating lowest responsible bidder as OMG Midwest, Inc. d/b/a Des Moines Asphalt & Paving, Kevin Bragg, President, \$1,164,172.

### SYNOPSIS:

This is a public hearing to allow for public input on the Martin Luther King Jr. Parkway Rehabilitation from Hickman Road to Euclid Avenue and take the necessary actions as required by Iowa Code to authorize a contract for construction of the proposed project. This project provides for the resurfacing Martin Luther King Jr. Parkway from Hickman Road to Euclid Avenue.

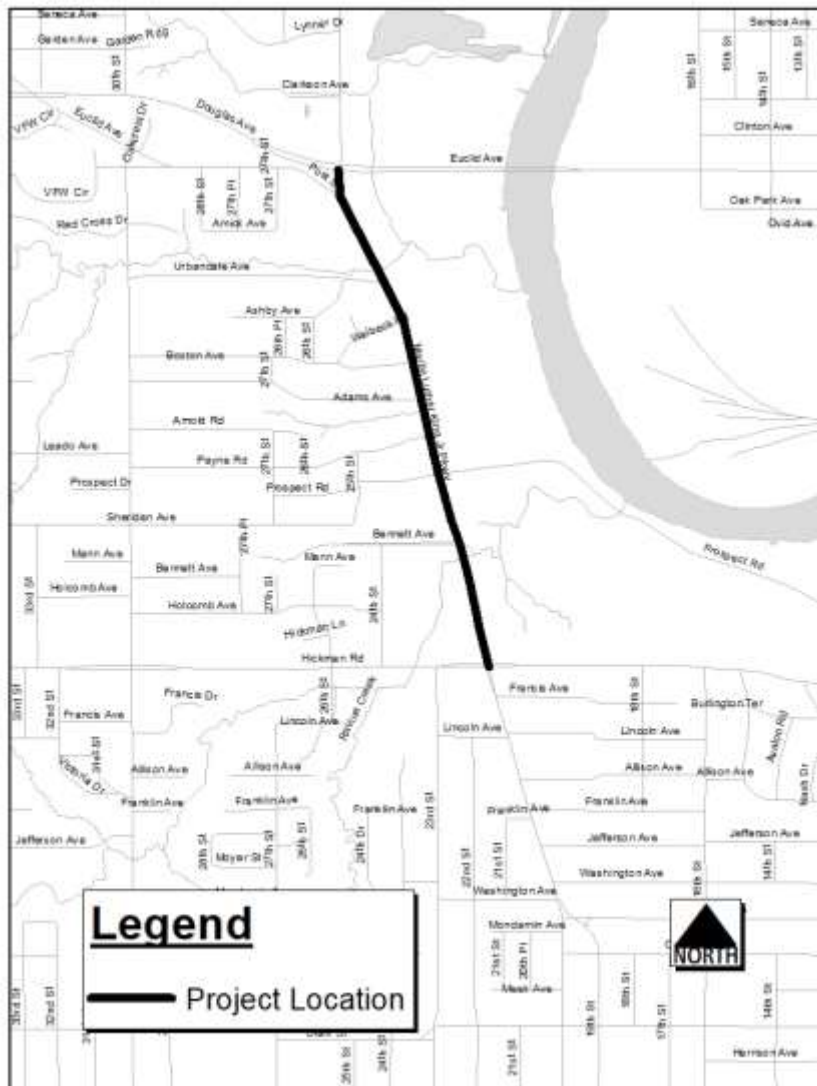

### ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

- On February 10, 2020, under Roll Call No. 20-0210, the City Council received and filed plans, specifications, form of contract documents, and City Engineer's estimate for the construction of the Martin Luther King Jr. Parkway Rehabilitation from Hickman Road to Euclid Avenue. Before the City Council can enter into a contract, it must hold a public hearing and approve the proposed plans, specifications, and form of contract documents and engineer's estimate for the construction of the Martin Luther King Jr. Parkway Rehabilitation from Hickman Road to Euclid Avenue, 06-2020-003.
- The improvement includes Portland Cement Concrete (PCC) full depth patches, sidewalk, driveways, medians, milling, Hot Mix Asphalt (HMA) overlay, modified subbase, subdrain, storm sewer intakes, pavement markings, traffic control, seeding, miscellaneous associated work including cleanup and restoration; all in accordance with the contract documents, including Plan File Nos. 615-209/243, located at Martin Luther King Jr. Parkway from Hickman Road to Euclid Avenue.

- Sealed bids for said improvement were submitted by the following bidders:
  - OMG Midwest, Inc. d/b/a Des Moines Asphalt & Paving, Ankeny, IA
  - Grimes Asphalt and Paving Corporation, Des Moines, IA
  - Hawkeye Paving Corporation, Bettendorf, IA
  - Jasper Construction Services, Inc., Newton, IA
  - TK Concrete, Inc., Pella, IA
  
- The bids were received and opened at a public meeting presided over by the Engineer in the City Council Chambers, 2nd Floor, City Hall, 400 Robert D. Ray Drive, Des Moines, Iowa at 11:00 a.m. on February 25, 2020.
  
- The City Engineer has determined that the lowest responsive, responsible bid for the construction of said improvement was submitted by Asphalt & Paving, Kevin Bragg, President, 2401 SE Tones Drive, Suite 13, Ankeny, IA, 50021 in the amount of \$1,164,172.00, and said bid should be accepted. The Finance Director has determined that funds are available for said improvement as stated above.
