AGENDA HEADING:

Schedule of administrative penalties for public nuisance depositing dirt, debris, or other material on public property and for discharge of water on sidewalks, streets, and real property in violation of Chapter 42 of the Chapter 42 of the Municipal Code.

SYNOPSIS:

Recommend approving the schedule of administrative penalties for violations of specifically identified nuisances in Section 42-348(25) and Section 42-348(26) of the Municipal Code regarding depositing dirt, debris, or other material on public property and for discharge of water on sidewalks, streets, and real property.

FISCAL IMPACT: NONE

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

- At the March 23, 2020 meeting, City Council approved amendments to Chapter 42 of the Municipal Code adding the option to use administrative penalties for the public nuisances for discharging water or depositing dirt, debris, and other material from private property onto public sidewalks, streets, or real property in addition to the normal nuisance abatement process.
- Staff has prepared a recommended schedule of administrative penalties in the amount of \$100 for the first offense, \$150 for the second offense, and \$200 for the third offense for both referenced public nuisances.
