AGENDA HEADING:

Hearing on Easton Boulevard Resurfacing from Hubbell Avenue to E. 33rd Street: Resolution approving plans, specifications, form of contract documents, engineer's estimate, receive and file bids, and designating lowest responsible bidder as Grimes Asphalt and Paving Corporation, Timothy Mallicoat, President, \$515,942.10.

SYNOPSIS:

This is a public hearing to allow for public input on the Easton Boulevard Resurfacing from Hubbell Avenue to E. 33rd Street and take the necessary actions as required by Iowa Code to authorize a contract for construction of the proposed project. This project includes resurfacing of Easton Boulevard from Hubbell Avenue to E. 33rd Street, changing pavement markings on Easton Boulevard between Hubbell Avenue and E. 29th Street from a two-lane cross section to a three-lane cross section, and other traffic and drainage improvements along the corridor.

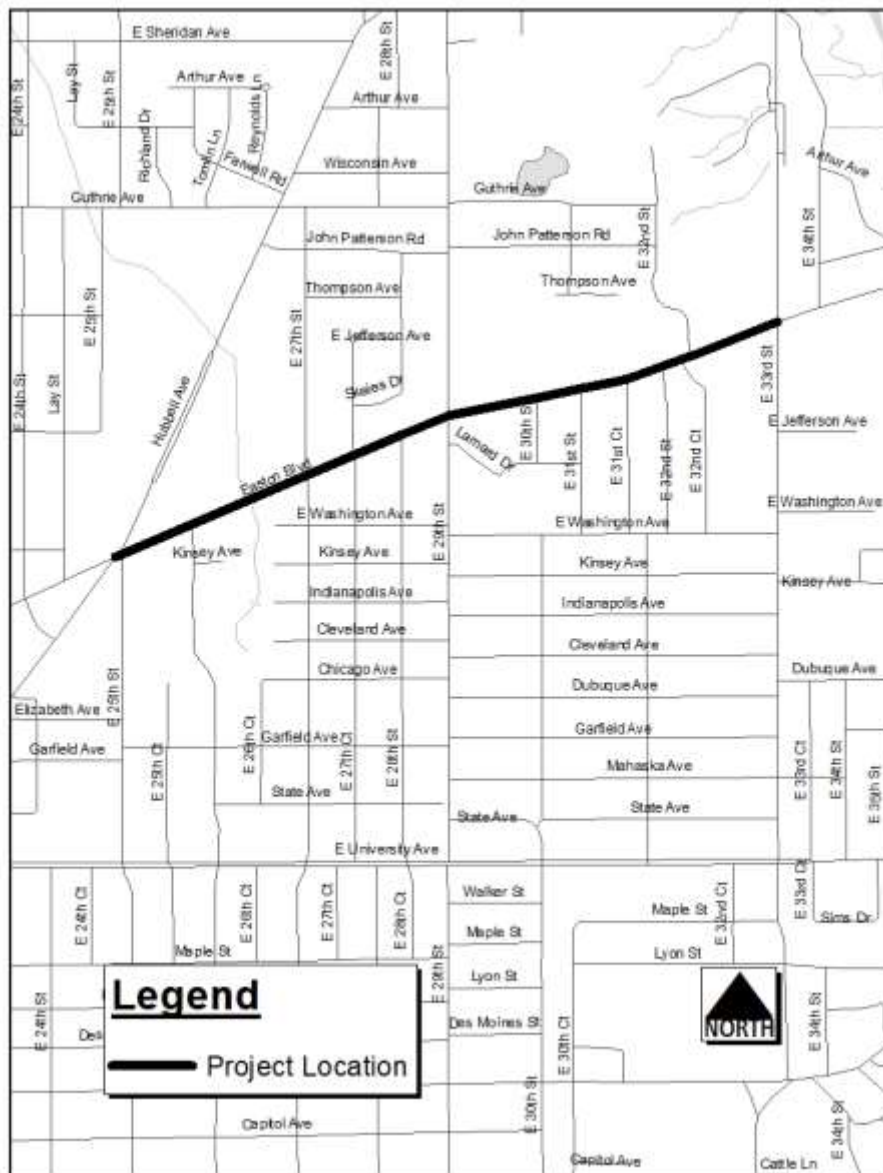
Amount: \$515,942.10 Construction Contract (\$650,000 City Engineer's Estimate)

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

- On March 23, 2020, under Roll Call No. 20-0503, the City Council received and filed plans, specifications, form of contract documents, and City Engineer's estimate for the construction of the Easton Boulevard Resurfacing from Hubbell Avenue to E. 33rd Street. Before the City Council can enter into a contract, it must hold a public hearing and approve the proposed plans, specifications, and form of contract documents and engineer's estimate for the construction of the Easton Boulevard Resurfacing from Hubbell Avenue to E. 33rd Street, 06-2020-004. The improvement includes pavement scarification, Hot Mix Asphalt (HMA) overlay, Portland Cement Concrete (PCC) sidewalk, storm sewer, storm sewer intakes, PCC median, pavement markings, and other incidental items; in accordance with the contract documents, including Plans File Nos. 616-169/199, on Easton Boulevard from Hubbell Avenue to E. 33rd Street.
- Sealed bids for said improvement were submitted by the following bidders:
 - Grimes Asphalt and Paving Corporation, Des Moines, IA
 - OMG Midwest, Inc. d/b/a Des Moines Asphalt & Paving, Ankeny, IA

- Minturn, Inc., Brooklyn, IA - bid read under advisement – Proposal Addendum No. 2 not acknowledged
- InRoads, LLC, Des Moines, IA - bid not read – bidder did not return entire Proposal
- The bids were received and opened at a public meeting presided over by the Engineer in the City Council Chambers, 2nd Floor, City Hall, 400 Robert D. Ray Drive, Des Moines, Iowa at 11:00 a.m. on April 21, 2020.
- The City Engineer has determined that the lowest responsive, responsible bid for the construction of said improvement was submitted by Grimes Asphalt and Paving Corporation, (Timothy Mallicoat, President, 5550 NE 22nd Street, Des Moines, IA, 50313) in the amount of \$515,942.10, and said bid should be accepted. The Finance Director has determined that funds are available for said improvement as stated above.
