#### **AGENDA HEADING:**

Hearing on E. 29th Street Rehabilitation from Easton Boulevard to Euclid Avenue: Resolution approving plans, specifications, form of contract documents, engineer's estimate, receive and file bids, and designating lowest responsible bidder as Grimes Asphalt and Paving Corporation, Timothy Mallicoat, President, \$496,721.63.

#### **SYNOPSIS:**

This is a public hearing to allow for public input on the E. 29th Street Rehabilitation from Easton Boulevard to Euclid Avenue and take the necessary actions as required by Iowa Code to authorize a contract for construction of the proposed project. This project will rehabilitate deteriorated roadway pavement for E. 29th Street resurfacing from Easton Boulevard to Euclid Avenue which includes scarification of the existing roadway, resurfacing with Hot Mix Asphalt (HMA), and traffic signal modifications.


Amount: \$496,721.63 Construction Contract (\$750,000 City Engineer's estimate)

<u>Funding Source</u>: 2020-21 Pending CIP, Page Street – 33, Roadway Reconstruction, ST260, Being: \$496,721.63 Surface Transportation Block Grant Program Federal-aid Swap funds (80% of eligible construction costs, or \$500,000 max)

## ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

• On March 23, 2020, under Roll Call No. 20-0504, the City Council received and filed plans, specifications, form of contract documents, and City Engineer's estimate for the construction of the E. 29th Street Rehabilitation from Easton Boulevard to Euclid Avenue. Before the City Council can enter into a contract, it must hold a public hearing and approve the proposed plans, specifications, and form of contract documents and engineer's estimate for the construction of the E. 29th Street Rehabilitation from Easton Boulevard to Euclid Avenue, 06-2019-006. The improvement includes pavement scarification and HMA overlay, Portland Cement Concrete (PCC) patching, PCC sidewalk, pavement markings, traffic signal modifications, and other incidental items; all in accordance with the contract documents, including Plans File Nos. 613-225/247, on E. 29th Street from Easton Boulevard to Euclid Avenue.

- Sealed bids for said improvement were submitted by the following bidders:
  - o Grimes Asphalt and Paving Corporation, Des Moines, IA
  - o InRoads, LLC, Des Moines, IA
  - o OMG Midwest, Inc. d/b/a Des Moines Asphalt & Paving, Ankeny, IA
- The bids, in accordance with a previously approved Iowa Department of Transportation (IDOT) Agreement, were received and opened by the IDOT on April 21, 2020.
- The City Engineer has determined that the lowest responsive, responsible bid for the construction of said improvement was submitted by Grimes Asphalt and Paving Corporation, (Timothy Mallicoat, President, 5550 NE 22nd Street, Des Moines, IA, 50313) in the amount of \$496,721.63, and said bid should be accepted. The Finance Director has determined that funds are available for said improvement as stated above.
