AGENDA HEADING:

Hearing on Simon Estes Amphitheater Repairs: Resolution approving plans, specifications, form of contract documents, engineer's estimate, receive and file bids, and designating lowest responsible bidder as Minturn, Inc., Clinton M. Rhoads, President, \$573,874.

SYNOPSIS:

This is a public hearing to allow for public input on the Simon Estes Amphitheater Repairs and take the necessary actions as required by Iowa Code to authorize a contract for construction of the proposed project. The amphitheater was scoured and sustained damage during flooding events in 2019. Steel sheeting was placed in the river to stabilize the site and to provide permanent scour repairs to the site. This project provides for the final site repairs and reconstruction of the damaged elements to restore the site to full functionality.




ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

• On May 4, 2020, under Roll Call No. 20-0731, the City Council received and filed plans, specifications, form of contract documents, and City Engineer's estimate for the construction of the Simon Estes Amphitheater Repairs. Before the City Council can enter into a contract, it must hold a public hearing and approve the proposed plans, specifications, and form of contract documents and engineer's estimate for the construction of the Simon Estes Amphitheater Repairs, 04-2020-022. The improvement includes structural connections to existing steel sheet pile, coring and grouting under existing Des Moines River box, rebuilding lower River walkway with Portland Cement Concrete (PCC), dewatering, storm sewer, intakes, sanitary manholes, removal of existing revetment and re-establishing site grades, pavement removal PCC colored sidewalk, irrigation repairs, site electrical repairs, and site restoration and sodding; all in accordance with the contract documents, including Plan File Nos. 617-273/285, located at Simon Estes Amphitheater, 75 E. Locust Street.

- Sealed bids for said improvement were submitted by the following bidders:
 - o Minturn, Inc., Brooklyn, IA
 - o Jasper Construction Services, Inc., Newton, IA
 - o Jensen Construction Company, Des Moines, IA
- The bids were received and opened at a public meeting presided over by the Engineer in the City Council Chambers, 2nd Floor, City Hall, 400 Robert D. Ray Drive, Des Moines, Iowa at 11:00 a.m. on May 19, 2020.
- The City Engineer has determined that the lowest responsive, responsible bid for the
 construction of said improvement was submitted by Minturn, Inc. (Clinton M. Rhoads,
 President, 144 W. Front Street, Brooklyn, IA, 52211), in the amount of \$573,874, and said bid
 should be accepted. The Finance Director has determined that funds are available for said
 improvement as stated above.
- Due to the planned construction of the Walnut Street Bridge directly adjacent to the Simon Estes Amphitheater set to begin in 2022 and last through 2023 the Simon Estes Amphitheater will not open until 2024.
