### AGENDA HEADING:

Approval of purchase of four (4) Hewlett-Packard (HP) servers for use by the Information Technology (IT) Department that will support current software technologies and provide additional capacity for growth.

### SYNOPSIS:

Recommend approval of the purchase of four (4) HP servers from OneNeck IT Solutions (11191 Aurora Avenue, Urbandale, IA 50322, Terry Swanson, President and CEO), per NASPO VP - HPE MNNVP-134, State of Iowa Master Agreement 005 16054C).

### ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

- Replacing obsolete server equipment is essential to maintaining efficient performance and reliable access to software applications and data that support City operations.
- This budgeted expenditure will allow the IT Department to replace HP servers that are nearing the end of their operational life and will no longer support current and future server and database technologies.
- The upgraded equipment will provide improved performance and additional capacity for server virtualization growth. These servers are required for replacement of equipment in the Armory data center.
