

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

- On July 15, 2019, under Roll Call No. 19-1152, the City Council approved plans and specifications and designated the lowest responsible bidder as RW Excavating Solutions, LC for \$3,076,133.60. The project includes the stabilization of the Yeader Creek channel in five (5) locations identified as proposed projects in the Easter Lake Water Quality Management Plan that was completed in 2012 in partnership with the Iowa Department of Natural Resources (IDNR) and Polk County. These channel locations were prioritized by the City of Des Moines, Polk County and the IDNR in the 2012 Easter Lake Water Quality Management plan as being necessary to improve the water quality in Easter Lake.
- Change Order No. 1 adds additional length of channel stabilization as coordinated with Polk County and the IDNR. The project added Section YC C south tributary and additional length of Section YC 10 channel stabilization. The additional stabilization work includes storm sewer and subdrains, clearing and grubbing, excavation and haul off, manhole repairs and replacements, rip rap for additional slope protection, and will modify the completion date to complete the additional work.
