#### **AGENDA HEADING:**

Amending Chapter 114 of the Municipal Code regarding traffic regulation changes as follows:

- A. Proposed code change to match field conditions on the north side of Pleasant Street from 9th Street to 10th Street.
- B. Proposed code change to remove mid-block parking restrictions on the south side of Locust Street, from 2nd Avenue to the Des Moines River Bridge.
- C. Code Correction—9th Street between Shawnee Avenue and Aurora Avenue.
- D. Parking Restriction—Westwood Drive between 56th Street and the cul-de-sac to the east.
- E. One-Way Restriction—Carpenter Avenue between 11th Street and 13th Street.

#### **SYNOPSIS:**

Recommend approval of the staff recommendation and the ordinance regarding the traffic regulation changes.



### ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:


A. Due to the addition of bump outs, morning parking restrictions are no longer appropriate on the north side of Pleasant Street. The proposed code change will modify the Municipal Code to remove the 7:00 a.m. to 9:00 a.m. rush-hour restriction on the north side of Pleasant Street from 9th Street to 10th Street.



Sec. 114-3574. Pleasant Street--Ninth Street to Tenth Street.

Pleasant Street, on the north side, from Ninth Street to Tenth Street, no parking 7:00 a.m. to 9:00 a.m.

B. With the Locust Street Bridge opening, DART would like to shift the D-Line stop closer to the intersection of 2nd Avenue.




Sec. 114-3419. Locust Street--Robert D Ray Drive to Second Avenue.

Locust Street, on the south side, from a point 214 feet east of Second Avenue to a point 39 feet west thereof, no parking any time.

Locust Street, on the south side, from Second Avenue to a point 50 85 feet east thereof, no parking any time.


C. A parking restriction on the west side of 9th Street between Shawnee Avenue and Aurora Avenue was recently approved by Council to address sight distance concerns. An error was made in the length of the restriction. The restriction should be 365-feet long rather than the 335-feet that was approved. The following revision to the Municipal Code corrects this error and will place this change into effect.



Sec. 114-2695. Ninth Street--Keosauqua Way to Aurora Avenue.

Ninth Street, on the west side, from a point 335 365 feet south of Aurora Avenue to Aurora Avenue, no parking any time.

D. A resident expressed concern about parked vehicles on Westwood Drive east of 56th Street creating sight distance and maneuverability concerns especially within the curve. Parking is currently prohibited on the north/west side of Westwood Drive from 56th Street to the cul-de-sac to the east. Parking is also prohibited within the cul-de-sac. This item was originally presented to Council at the July 13, 2020 meeting. At that time, Council referred the item back to staff for further review. Staff has reviewed the conditions and data and staff's recommendation remains the same. A field review of Westwood Drive east of 56th Street was completed by Traffic and Transportation staff. Based on the posted speed limit of 25 mph, street width and maneuverability through the curve, staff recommends removing parking on the east/south side of Westwood Drive within the curve. It is also recommended that a 50-foot corner clearance parking restriction be added on the south side of Westwood Drive at the intersection of 56th Street to better accommodate traffic turning at the intersection. The following revisions to the Municipal Code will place these changes into effect.



Sec. 114-3781. Westwood Drive--Fifty sixth Street to dead end east cul-de-sac east of Fifty-sixth Street to Fifty-sixth Street.


Westwood Drive, on the north side, from Fifty-sixth Street to a point 380 feet east thereof and any part of the cul-de-sac, no parking any time.

Westwood Drive, on the north side, from and including the cul-de-sac east of Fifty-sixth Street to Fifty-sixth Street, no parking any time.

Westwood Drive, on the south side, from a point 365 feet east of Fifty-sixth Street to a point 215 feet west thereof, no parking any time.

Westwood Drive, on the south side, from a point 50 feet east of Fifty-sixth Street to Fifty-sixth Street, no parking any time.

E. The King Irving Neighborhood Association, through the Ward Council Member, asked staff to develop alternatives on Carpenter Avenue near 11th Street to address a concern for the flow of traffic east/west along Carpenter Avenue. The proposed alternative would convert Carpenter Avenue between 11th Street and 13th Street to a one-way westbound operation. The King Irving Neighborhood Association has approved the proposed alternative. This alternative was also presented to and approved by the Transportation Safety Committee at the August 11, 2020 meeting. The following revision to the Municipal Code will place this change into effect.



Sec. 114-1807. Carpenter Avenue.

Carpenter Avenue, from Eleventh Street to Thirteenth Street, westbound.
