• The U.S. Department of Homeland Security allocates funds to states and local governments through the federal Homeland Security Grant Program (HSGP) for approved initiatives supporting national priorities and state strategies directed toward prevention, response, mitigation and recovery efforts related to terrorist attacks. A grant (HSGP-20-04-01) of up to \$635,000 has been awarded to the City as subrecipient. In order to transfer the grant funding and responsibility for performance to the OCIO, the City must approve the 2020 HSGP Commitment to Award and Accept Funds agreement between IHSEMD and the City and a 2020 MOA with IHSEMD for the grant transfer to OCIO.
