Authorization to proceed with acquisition of the necessary property interests for the Western Ingersoll Run Sewer Separation Project by gift, negotiation, or eminent domain.

SYNOPSIS:

Recommend approval of authorization to proceed with acquisition of the necessary property interests for the Western Ingersoll Run Sewer Separation Project by gift, negotiation, or eminent domain. This action is required by Iowa law before the City can initiate the property acquisition process under eminent domain.



ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

- This project provides for construction of storm sewers in the Western Ingersoll Run Combined Sewer System to remove the remaining storm inlets from the combined sewer system in an area roughly bounded by Grand Avenue on the south, Forest Avenue on the north, 31st Street on the east, and Polk Boulevard on the west.
- The sewers in the Western Ingersoll basin are tributary to the Ingersoll Run Combined Sewer. The Ingersoll Run Combined Sewer is tributary to the Wastewater Reclamation Authority's (WRA) Combined Sewer Overflow (CSO) at 22nd and High Street. The City, WRA and the Iowa Department of Natural Resources (IDNR) have entered into a consent decree that requires the WRA to eliminate the CSO at 22nd and High Street no later than December 31, 2023.
- Phase 1 of this project will require approximately 22 temporary construction easements and two (2) permanent easements from 24 property owners. Relocation assistance will not be required for this project.
- Property interests for Phase 2 and Phase 3 of this project will be determined after design is completed.
