#### **AGENDA HEADING:**

## **SYNOPSIS:**

This is a public hearing to allow for public input on the Historic Pillar Repair on Southwest Corner of Chaffee Road and Army Post Road and take the necessary actions as required by Iowa Code to authorize a contract for construction of the proposed project. This project includes the repair of the existing stone gate structure on the west side of Chaffee Road at the entrance to the Fort Des Moines south of East Army Post Road.



## **ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:**

• On October 19, 2020, under Roll Call No. 20-1640, the City Council received and filed plans, specifications, form of contract documents, and City Engineer's estimate for the construction of the Historic Pillar Repair on Southwest Corner of Chaffee Road and Army Post Road. Before the City Council can enter into a contract, it must hold a public hearing and approve the proposed plans, specifications, and form of contract documents and engineer's estimate for the construction of the Historic Pillar Repair on Southwest Corner of Chaffee Road and Army Post Road, 042020028. The improvement includes the repair and reconstruction of the damaged stone entrance pier located at the southwest corner of East Army Post Road and Chaffee Road; all in accordance with the contract documents, located at Fort Des Moines, 75 East Army Post Road.

- The City Engineer has determined that the lowest responsive, responsible bid for the construction of said improvement was submitted by Renaissance Restoration, Inc. (Terry W. Cole, President, 11672 W. Norris Lane, PO Box 291, Galena, IL), 61036 in the amount of \$44,390, and said bid should be accepted. The Finance Director has determined that funds are available for said improvement as stated above.
