AGENDA HEADING:

Hearing on 2020 Gray's Lake Shoreline Repair: Resolution approving plans, specifications, form of contract documents, engineer's estimate, receive and file bids, and designating lowest responsible bidder as RW Excavating Solutions, LC, Dan E. Wilson, Managing Member, \$225,587.50.

SYNOPSIS:

This is a public hearing to allow for public input on the 2020 Gray's Lake Shoreline Repair and take the necessary actions as required by Iowa Code to authorize a contract for construction of the proposed project. This project provides for the stabilization of erosion along the northern and eastern shoreline of Gray's Lake.

FISCAL IMPACT:

Amount: \$225,587.50 Construction Contract (\$325,000 City Engineer's Estimate)

Funding Source: 2020-2021 CIP, Page Parks - 10, Gray's Lake Park Improvements, PK140, G. O. Bonds, Being: \$32,123 in United States Department of Agriculture (USDA) for Emergency Watershed Protection (EWP) Program Funding (NR206114XXXXC037), and the remaining \$193,464.50 in GO. Bonds.

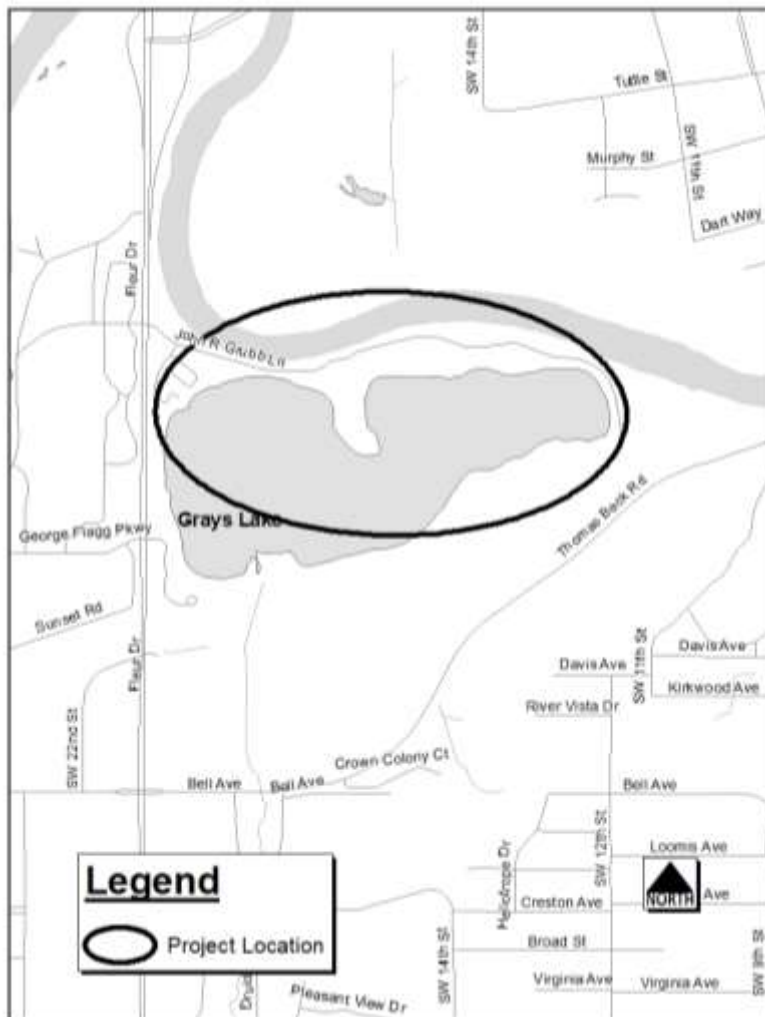
ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

- On November 9, 2020, under Roll Call No. 20-1744, the City Council received and filed plans, specifications, form of contract documents, and City Engineer's estimate for the construction of the 2020 Gray's Lake Shoreline Repair. Before the City Council can enter into a contract, it must hold a public hearing and approve the proposed plans, specifications, and form of contract documents and engineer's estimate for the construction of the 2020 Gray's Lake Shoreline Repair, 11-2021-005. The improvement includes shoreline stabilization construction including bank grading and shaping, rip rap, sheet pile retaining wall, seeding, erosion control, restoration, and miscellaneous associated work including cleanup and other incidental items; all in accordance with the contract documents including Plan File Nos. 625-001/012, located along the shoreline of Gray's Lake.

- Sealed bids for said improvement were submitted by the following bidders:

- The bids were received and opened at a public meeting presided over by the City Engineer in the City Council Chambers, 2nd Floor, City Hall, 400 Robert D. Ray Drive, Des Moines, Iowa at 11:00 a.m. on November 24, 2020.

- The City Engineer has determined that the lowest responsive, responsible bid for the construction of said improvement was submitted by RW Excavating Solutions, LC (Dan E. Wilson, Managing Member, 13293 S. 88th Avenue W, Prairie City, IA, 50228), in the amount of \$225,587.50, and said bid should be accepted. The Finance Director has determined that funds are available for said improvement as stated above.
