AGENDA HEADING:

Approving first amendment to agreement between the City of Des Moines and IMPACT Community Action Partnership (IMPACT) for assumption as Community Action Agency serving the City of Des Moines.

SYNOPSIS:

The City of Des Moines entered into an agreement with IMPACT (formerly Red Rock Community Action Program, Inc.) on May 18, 2015 to assume the role as the Community Action Agency serving the City of Des Moines. The amendment is being requested by IMPACT.

FISCAL IMPACT: NONE

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

- The Des Moines City Council on May 18, 2015, by Roll Call No. 15-0871, approved the agreement with Red Rock Community Action Program, Inc. to assume the role as the Community Action Agency serving the City of Des Moines. IMPACT has requested to make the following amendments to the agreement:
 - Reflect the change of organizational name from Red Rock Community Action Program, Inc. to IMPACT Community Action Partnership.
 - Establishes a minimum funding level for CSBG and LIHEAP funding on service to persons living within the City at 54.55%.
 - Specifies funding to be prorated as CSBG and LIHEAP funding, not “community action agency funds”.
 - The Des Moines Advisory Committee is eliminated due to representation on the Board references are removed.
 - Exhibit A has been deleted. This exhibit included programs provided by the City. IMPACT will provide the City Manager in writing programs they will offer.
