


A. The proposed code modification will remove parking restrictions on the south curb line of Raccoon Street between SE 6th and SE 7th Streets. The following revision to the Municipal Code will place this change into effect.



Sec. 114-3586. Raccoon Street--Dead end west of Southeast Second Street to Scott Avenue.

Raccoon Street, on the south side, from Southeast Sixth Street to a point 50 feet west thereof, no parking any time.

B. Remove parking from the north side of Cherry Street between 8th and 9th Streets to accommodate changes caused by the Cherry Street resurfacing project. The following revision to the Municipal Code will place this change into effect.



Sec. 114-3073. Cherry Street--Eighth Street to Ninth Street.

Cherry Street, on the north both sides, from Eighth Street to Ninth Street, no parking any time.
