AGENDA HEADING:

Approving Supplemental Agreement No. 3 to the Professional Services Agreement (PSA) with Veenstra & Kimm, Inc. for additional construction phase services for Market District Sanitary Sewer Improvements, not to exceed \$90,448.

SYNOPSIS:

Recommend approval of Supplemental Agreement No. 3 to the PSA with Veenstra & Kimm, Inc. (H.R. Veenstra, Jr., President, 3000 Westown Parkway, West Des Moines, Iowa, 50266), for an additional amount not to exceed \$90,448, based on hourly rates, to provide additional construction phase services for Market District Sanitary Sewer Improvements.



ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

- The Market District Sanitary Sewer Improvements project includes:
 - O Construction of a new sanitary sewer trunk line through the Market District from E. 4th Street and E. Vine Street to E. 12th Street and E. Raccoon Street.
 - Construction of a new sanitary sewer pump station near E. 12th Street and E. Raccoon Street.
 - Construction of a new sanitary force main from E. 12th Street and E. Raccoon Street to E. 20th Street and Martin Luther King Jr. Parkway.
- Proposed development within the Market District is on a timeline such that the provision
 of sanitary sewer service was required to be designed and constructed as soon as possible.
 Portions of the overall project are currently under construction with the remainder to
 commence construction this spring.
- On December 17, 2018, by Roll Call No. 18-2045, City Council approved the PSA with Veenstra & Kimm, Inc. to provide design phase services for Market District Sanitary Sewer Improvements, not to exceed \$104,464.

- On December 2, 2019, by Roll Call No. 19-0901, City Council approved Supplemental Agreement No. 1 to the Agreement for Professional Services with Veenstra & Kimm, Inc., for an additional amount not to exceed \$42,998, based on hourly rates, to provide final design of gravity sanitary sewer and limited construction administration services associated with the sanitary sewer pump station project.
- On March 9, 2020, by Roll Call No. 20-0403, City Council approved Supplemental Agreement No. 2 to the Agreement for Professional Services with Veenstra & Kimm, Inc., for an additional amount not to exceed \$174,158, based on hourly rates, for construction observation services associated with the sanitary sewer and force main project.
- Staff has negotiated Supplemental Agreement No. 3 to the Agreement for Professional Services with Veenstra & Kimm, Inc. for a total additional amount not to exceed \$90,448, based on hourly rates, for additional construction phase services associated with the sanitary sewer and force main project. The construction project schedule is being extended to accommodate additional time and costs that were required to obtain a permit from the railroad, which slowed the contractor's progress. Supplemental Agreement No. 3 will compensate Veenstra & Kimm for the additional labor and expenses necessary to provide construction administration and observation services for the period beyond the original construction completion date.
