AGENDA HEADING:

Approving the purchase of a replacement compact tracked skid steer loader for use in the Parks and Recreation Department.

SYNOPSIS:

Recommend approval of the purchase of a replacement compact tracked skid steer loader for use by the Parks and Recreation Department from Clark Equipment Company d/b/a Bobcat Company, Government Sales (250 East Beaton Drive, West Fargo, ND 58078, David Rowles, President), utilizing State of Iowa contract MA 005-17312C in the amount of \$60,709.30.

FISCAL IMPACT:

Amount: \$60,709.30

Funding Source: 2021-2022 Operating Budget, Page 83, I201, Equipment Replacement.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

- Two (2) compact utility tractors that meet or exceed replacement criteria were approved for replacement by the Fleet Oversight Committee for replacement with a single compact track loader (skid steer). Bobcat brand equipment meeting the needs of the department is available from the State of Iowa purchasing contract from Clark Equipment Company (d/b/a Bobcat Company) and is therefore recommended for award.
- Although all electric equipment is being researched and developed by the Bobcat Company, there is not currently an electric model commercially available in this class of equipment, (92-horsepower, 10,000-pound operating weight).
