AGENDA HEADING:

Approving the purchase of two (2) replacement vehicles for use by the Police Department.

SYNOPSIS:

Recommend the approval to purchase two (2) replacement hybrid pursuit SUVs for use by the Police Department utilizing the State of Iowa DAS contract MA 20103 from Stivers Ford (1450 E. Hickman Road, Waukee, Iowa 50263, Scott Politte, General Manager), in the amount of \$72,109.

FISCAL IMPACT:

Amount: \$72,109

Funding Source: 2021-2022 Operating Budget, page 81, I201 Equipment Replacement.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

- These two (2) recommended hybrid pursuit rated SUVs will be evaluated and compared to previously awarded conventional Internal Combustion Engine (ICE) only units for increased fuel efficiency and reduced emissions. The incremental increase in cost of approximately \$3,650 for the hybrid technology may be offset with reduced fuel consumption.
