- Amend and update Appendix C Approved Economic Development and Redevelopment Activities which provides a summary of projects receiving or proposed to receive economic development assistance and to update text for other previously-approved projects to receive tax increment revenues from the Metro Center Urban Renewal Area:
 - Urban Campus Apartments L.L.L.P. for the new construction of a 5-story, 42-unit multi-family residential project, to be located at 1230 6th Avenue.
 - SW9 215, LLC, preliminary terms for the construction of a 5-story, 66-unit multifamily housing project located on vacant, City-owned property at 215 SW 9th Street.
 - Des Moines Climate Controlled Storage, LLC, for the construction of a new 4-story,
 153,600-square-foot storage complex located at 503 SE 12th Street.

- Update the Financial Condition Report to reflect the new projects and material amendments to existing projects incorporated in Appendix C and D.
- Amend and update Appendix D Approved Public Improvement, Street and Parking projects
 to provide a listing of projects scheduled for funding from tax increment revenues in the Metro
