AGENDA HEADING:

Approving the purchase of two (2) replacement emergency generators and one (1) new emergency generator used for power back up for the City of Des Moines Information Technology (IT) Department at the following locations: the Police Academy; 9th and Locust Parking Ramp; and the City building located at 3226 University Avenue. These generators will be purchased using the Sourcewell contract No. 120617-KOH with Electrical Engineering and Equipment (3E), 953 73rd Street, Windsor Heights, Iowa, 50324, Steve VanBrocklin, President.

SYNOPSIS:

The Facility Management Division worked with IMEG Corporation engineering to provide a comprehensive set of specification standards for the purchase of replacement emergency generators to be located at the Police Academy, 9th and Locust Parking Garage, and the City building located at 3226 University Avenue. The Procurement Division will be utilizing the Sourcewell Cooperative Agreement.
