AGENDA HEADING:

Request acceptance of the COPS Anti-Heroin grant through the Governor's Office of Drug Control Policy designated to reimburse law enforcement overtime associated with mid-to-high level heroin investigations.

SYNOPSIS:

The Police Department requests approval to accept a grant award from the Governor's Office of Drug Control Policy in the amount of \$7,777 with a performance period of July 1, 2021, through June 30, 2021, and no match requirement. The funding is directed to support the law enforcement investigation of heroin related cases.
