AGENDA HEADING:

Hearing on Evergreen Avenue Rehabilitation from Marion Street to S.E. 30th Court: Resolution approving plans, specifications, form of contract documents, engineer's estimate, receive and file bids, and designating lowest responsible bidder as Grimes Asphalt and Paving Corporation, Timothy Mallicoat, President, \$427,660.75.

SYNOPSIS:

This is a public hearing to allow for public input on the Evergreen Avenue Rehabilitation from Marion Street to S.E. 30th Court and take the necessary actions as required by Iowa Code to authorize a contract for construction of the proposed project. This project provides for full-depth patching and the resurfacing of Evergreen Avenue utilizing surface scarification and Hot Mix Asphalt (HMA) overlay to improve the surface condition and to extend the useful service life of the street.



ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

- On October 18, 2021, under Roll Call No. 21-1535, the City Council received and filed plans, specifications, form of contract documents, and City Engineer's estimate for the construction of the Evergreen Avenue Rehabilitation from Marion Street to S.E. 30th Court. Before the City Council can enter into a contract, it must hold a public hearing and approve the proposed plans, specifications, and form of contract documents and engineer's estimate for the construction of the Evergreen Avenue Rehabilitation from Marion Street to S.E. 30th Court, Activity ID 06-2019-021. The improvement includes scarification, furnish and place HMA pavement, Portland Cement Concrete (PCC) pavement, pavement removal, traffic control, seeding, and other incidental items; in accordance with the contract documents, including Plan File No. 635-001/034 located on Evergreen Avenue from Marion Street to S.E. 30th Court.
- Sealed bids for said improvement were submitted by the following bidders:
 - o Grimes Asphalt and Paving Corporation, Des Moines, IA, Low Bid
 - o InRoads, LLC, Des Moines, IA

- o OMG Midwest, Inc. d/b/a Des Moines Asphalt & Paving, Ankeny, IA
- o Choice Concrete, L.L.C., Altoona, IA
- The bids were received and opened at a public meeting presided over by the City Engineer in the City Council Chambers, 2nd Floor, City Hall, 400 Robert D. Ray Drive, Des Moines, Iowa at 11:00 a.m. on November 2, 2021.
- The City Engineer has determined that the lowest responsive, responsible bid for the construction of said improvement was submitted by Grimes Asphalt and Paving Corporation (Timothy Mallicoat, President, 5550 NE 22nd Street, Des Moines, IA, 50313), in the amount of \$427,660.75, and said bid should be accepted. The Finance Director has determined that funds are available for said improvement as stated above.
- Construction of this public improvement project is anticipated to start in the spring 2022 and be complete by fall 2022.
