AGENDA HEADING:

Ordering construction of the following: George Flagg Parkway Resurfacing from Fleur Drive to SW 30th Street - Receiving bids, (12-21-21), and Setting date of hearing, (1-24-22). Construction Estimate - \$550,000.

Recommend the City Council order construction of the improvement and set dates to receive bids and hold a public hearing, as required by Iowa Code, utilizing the method of financing referenced below. The project includes roadway resurfacing along George Flagg Parkway from 350 feet west of Fleur Drive to S.W. 30th Street.



ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

- The Engineering Department has prepared plans, specifications, form of contract documents, and City Engineer's estimate for the construction of the George Flagg Parkway Resurfacing from Fleur Drive to SW 30th Street, Activity ID 06-2020-017. The improvement includes base widening with 4-inch thick Hot Mix Asphalt (HMA) paving, 3-inch thick HMA overlay paving, 7-inch thick Portland Cement Concrete (PCC) paving, pavement scarification, PCC patching, pavement markings, erosion control, site restoration, and other associated work and incidental items; in accordance with the contract documents, including Plan File No. 637-152/175, along George Flagg Parkway from 350 feet west of Fleur Drive to S.W. 30th Street.
- The estimated construction cost is \$550,000. The proposed plans, specifications, and form of contract documents are available for public inspection in the Des Moines City Engineer's Office.
- The construction of this project is anticipated to begin in spring 2022 and be fully completed by end of summer 2022.
