AGENDA HEADING:

Hearing on 2022 Midblock Pedestrian Signal Improvements: Resolution approving plans, specifications, form of contract documents, engineer's estimate, receive and file bids, and designating lowest responsible bidder as Ti-Zack Concrete, Inc., Steve J. Rutt, President, \$434,210.

SYNOPSIS:

This is a public hearing to allow for public input on the 2022 Midblock Pedestrian Signal Improvements and take the necessary actions as required by Iowa Code to authorize a contract for construction of the proposed project. This project includes replacement of existing midblock pedestrian traffic signals with updated High-Intensity Activated Cross WalK (HAWK) signals at the following locations:

- S.W. 9th Street and Loomis Avenue, at Lincoln High School.
- E. 33rd Street and Cleveland Avenue, at Stowe Elementary.
- Beaver Avenue and Adams Avenue, at Holy Trinity Catholic School.

This project also includes the replacement of the existing school flashing assembly on E. 33rd Street at Grand View Christian School.

FISCAL IMPACT:

Amount: \$434,210 construction contract (\$425,000 City Engineer's Estimate).



ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

• On December 6, 2021, under Roll Call No. 21-1786, the City Council received and filed plans, specifications, form of contract documents, and City Engineer's estimate for the construction of the 2022 Midblock Pedestrian Signal Improvements. - The City Engineer has determined that the lowest responsive, responsible bid for the construction of said improvement was submitted by Ti-Zack Concrete, Inc. (Steve J. Rutt, President, 39352 221st Avenue, Le Center, MN, 56057), in the amount of \$434,210, and said bid should be accepted. The Finance Director has determined that funds are available for said improvement as stated above.
