AGENDA HEADING:

Recommend approval of the staff recommendation and the ordinance regarding the traffic regulation changes.

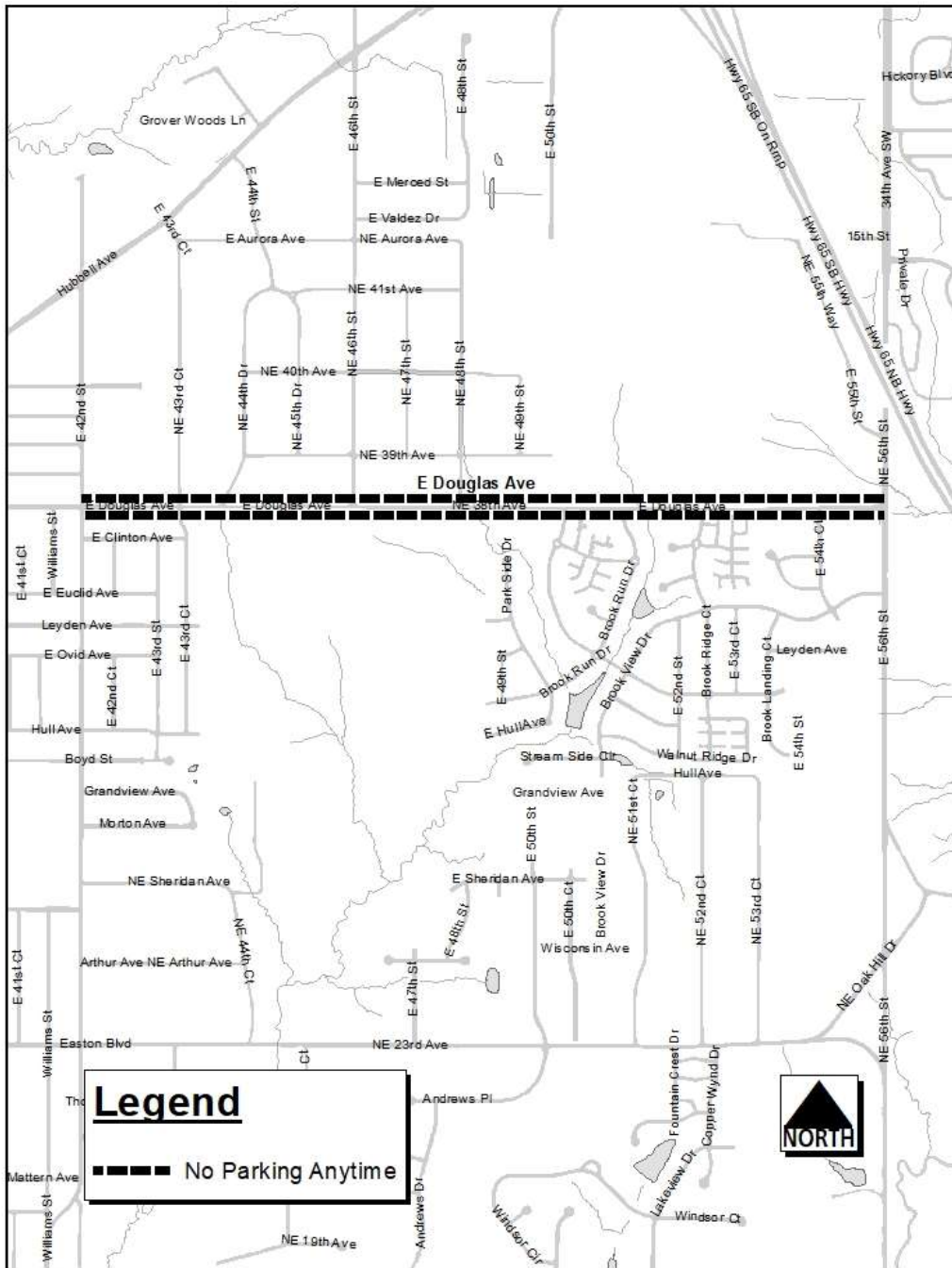
FISCAL IMPACT:

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

- East Douglas Avenue is currently under construction from East 42nd Street to NE 56th Street. This code change is required to match field conditions for parking restrictions on East Douglas Avenue based on the newly constructed street.



Sec. 114-3161. East Douglas Avenue--Delaware Avenue to east city limits.

East Douglas Avenue, on the south side, from East Forty-second Street to a point 100 feet east thereof, no parking any time.

East Douglas Avenue, on the south side, from a point 490 feet east of East Forty-second Street to the east city limits, no parking any time.

East Douglas Avenue, on the south side, from the east city limits to a point 100 feet west thereof, no parking any time.
