AGENDA HEADING:

Designation of lowest responsive, responsible bidder as Jensen Builders LTD., Dale H. Jensen, President; approval of contract and bond on Animal Control Facility Bid Package No. 1 – Structural Steel and Erection, \$699,700.

SYNOPSIS:

Recommend approval of contract and bond with the lowest responsive, responsible bidder as Jensen Builders LTD (Dale H. Jensen, President, 2097 NE 60th Avenue, Des Moines, IA, 50313), for the Animal Control Facility Bid Package No. 1 – Structural Steel and Erection project. The project provides the construction of an approximately 21,900-square-foot sustainable animal control facility operated by the City's current animal control services contractor, Animal Rescue League of Iowa. The new facility will be located on a 5.5-acre site east of S.E. 14th Street and between Harriet Street and the Des Moines River. The project is intended to better serve Des Moines' residents by replacing the existing outdated and undersized Animal Care and Control Center building. The new facility will be designed and submitted for LEED certification.


Amount: \$699,700 Construction Contract (\$455,000 City Engineer's Estimate)

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

- On February 21, 2022, under Roll Call No. 22-0273, the hearing on the plans, specifications, form of contract documents and Engineer's estimate of construction cost for said improvement was held and closed. Said plans, specifications, form of contract documents, and Engineer's estimate of construction cost were approved as the plans, specifications, form of contract documents, and Engineer's estimate of construction cost for said improvement, including Plan File No. 633-001/218, and bids for said improvement were received and filed.
- Since the apparent low bid was above the estimate, City staff determined it was necessary to
 discuss the outlook for funding of the overall project before proceeding with the award for this
 bid package.

• The City Engineer has determined that the lowest responsive, responsible bid for the construction of said improvement was submitted by Jensen Builders LTD (Dale H. Jensen, President, 2097 NE 60th Avenue, Des Moines, IA, 50313), in the amount of \$\$699,700, and said bid should be accepted. The Finance Director has determined that funds are available for said improvement as stated above.
