ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

- The Municipal Service Center – Phase 2 Building is currently under construction and is scheduled to open in 2022. The moving services contractor will be responsible to move items related to the nearly 300 employees and approximately 1,500 pieces of equipment affected by this relocation.
