AGENDA HEADING:

Hearing on Brook Run Park Improvements: Resolution approving plans, specifications, form of contract documents, engineer's estimate, receive and file bids, and designating lowest responsible bidder as Caliber Concrete, LLC, Jason Martin, Owner, \$411,897.50.

SYNOPSIS:

This is a public hearing to allow for public input on the Brook Run Park Improvements and take the necessary actions as required by Iowa Code to authorize a contract for construction of the proposed project. This project includes improvements to the existing Brook Run Park to increase accessibility and improve safety with the installation of additional playground equipment, replacement of the existing engineered wood fiber playground surfacing with rubber surfacing tiles, and the construction of a neighborhood sidewalk connection.


<u>Amount</u>: \$411,897.50 Construction Contract (\$400,000 City Engineer's Estimate)

<u>Funding Source</u>: 2022-23 CIP, Page 84, Park Playground Improvements, PK185, Being: \$242,147.50 G.O. Bonds and \$169,750 G.O. Bonds to be transferred from PK045.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

- On March 7, 2022, under Roll Call No. 22-0295, the City Council received and filed plans, specifications, form of contract documents, and City Engineer's estimate for the construction of the Brook Run Park Improvements. Before the City Council can enter into a contract, it must hold a public hearing and approve the proposed plans, specifications, and form of contract documents and engineer's estimate for the construction of the Brook Run Park Improvements, Activity ID 11-2022-001. The improvement includes clearing and grubbing, earthwork, storm sewer installation, Portland Cement Concrete (PCC) pavement, playground equipment, safety surfacing, seeding, and associated work including cleanup and restoration; all in accordance with the contract documents, including Plan File No. 639-260/269, located at Brook Run Park, 4901 E. Douglas Avenue.
- Sealed bids for said improvement were submitted by the following bidders:
 - o Caliber Concrete, LLC, Adair, IA, Low Bid
 - o GTG Construction, L.L.C., Johnston, IA

- The bids were received and opened at a public meeting presided over by the City Engineer in the City Council Chambers, 2nd Floor, City Hall, 400 Robert D. Ray Drive, Des Moines, Iowa at 11:00 a.m. on March 22, 2022.
- The City Engineer has determined that the lowest responsive, responsible bid for the construction of said improvement was submitted by Caliber Concrete, LLC (Jason Martin, Owner, 309 Audubon Street, Adair, IA, 50002), in the amount of \$411,897.50, and said bid should be accepted. The Finance Director has determined that funds are available for said improvement as stated above.
- Construction of this project is expected to begin in spring 2022 and be completed by fall 2022.
