AGENDA HEADING:

Amendment to the Chapter 42 noise control ordinance as it relates to the Lauridsen Amphitheater located in Water Works Park.

SYNOPSIS:

The ordinance would limit the hours of operation for concerts before Memorial Day and after Labor Day to assist with noise disturbances during the school year.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

- Due to complaints regarding the noise levels experienced in some neighborhoods to the north of the Lauridsen Amphitheater, the amplified sound will end at 9:00 p.m. Sunday through Thursday and will end at 10:00 p.m. on Friday and Saturday before Memorial Day and after Labor Day.
