AGENDA HEADING:

Hearing on 2022-2023 HMA Pavement Scarification and Resurfacing: Resolution approving plans, specifications, form of contract documents, engineer's estimate, receive and file bids, and designating lowest responsible bidder as OMG Midwest, Inc. dba Des Moines Asphalt & Paving, Kevin Bragg, President, \$186,158.

SYNOPSIS:

This is a public hearing to allow for public input on the 2022-2023 HMA Pavement Scarification and Resurfacing and take the necessary actions as required by Iowa Code to authorize a contract for construction of the proposed project. This project provides for the timely maintenance of residential and arterial streets utilizing surface scarification and Hot Mix Asphalt (HMA) overlay to improve the surface condition and extend the useful service life of the City's streets.


Amount: \$186,158 Construction Contract (\$168,500 City Engineer's Estimate).

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

- On April 4, 2022, under Roll Call No. 22-0515, the City Council received and filed plans, specifications, form of contract documents, and City Engineer's estimate for the construction of the 2022-2023 HMA Pavement Scarification and Resurfacing. Before the City Council can enter into a contract, it must hold a public hearing and approve the proposed plans, specifications, and form of contract documents and engineer's estimate for the construction of the 2022-2023 HMA Pavement Scarification and Resurfacing, 062022011. The improvement includes scarification only of 2-inch and 3-inch average depth of asphalt street surfaces with specified milling machine and equipment in a cooperative effort with the City of Des Moines Public Works Department, together with other incidental items and related work; all in accordance with the contract documents at the following locations within the City:
 - o York Street from Hull Avenue to E. Euclid Avenue
 - o E. 25th Street from Guthrie Avenue to E. Sheridan Avenue
 - o Guthrie Avenue from E. 16th Street to E. 14th Street
 - o 12th Street from Aurora Avenue to Madison Avenue

- o 49th Street from Grand Avenue to dead end south
- o S.W. 15th Street from Havens Avenue to Johnson Street
- o S.W. 13th Street from Park Avenue to Pleasant View Drive
- o E. 26th Street from E. Euclid Avenue to Wedgewood Road
- o 23rd Street from High Street to Ingersoll Avenue
- o E. 27th Street from Grandview Avenue to Hubbell Avenue
- o E. 17th Street from E. Walnut Street to E. Capital Avenue
