AGENDA HEADING:

Hearing on City-Wide Pavement Marking Program: Resolution approving plans, specifications, form of contract documents, engineer's estimate, receive and file bids, and designating lowest responsible bidder as Quality Striping, Inc., Jamie Jirak, President, \$266,180.

SYNOPSIS:

This is a public hearing to allow for public input on the City-Wide Pavement Marking Program and take the necessary actions as required by Iowa Code to authorize a contract for construction of the proposed project. This project provides for placement of pavement markings along the following roadway corridors:

- University Avenue from 25th Street to 31st Street.
- Franklin Avenue from 48th Street to Merle Hay Road.
- Euclid Avenue from 2nd Avenue to 12th Street.
- Oak Park Avenue from 6th Avenue to 11th Street.
- 11th Street from Oak Park Avenue to Clinton Avenue.
- Clinton Avenue from 6th Avenue to 11th Street.

FISCAL IMPACT:

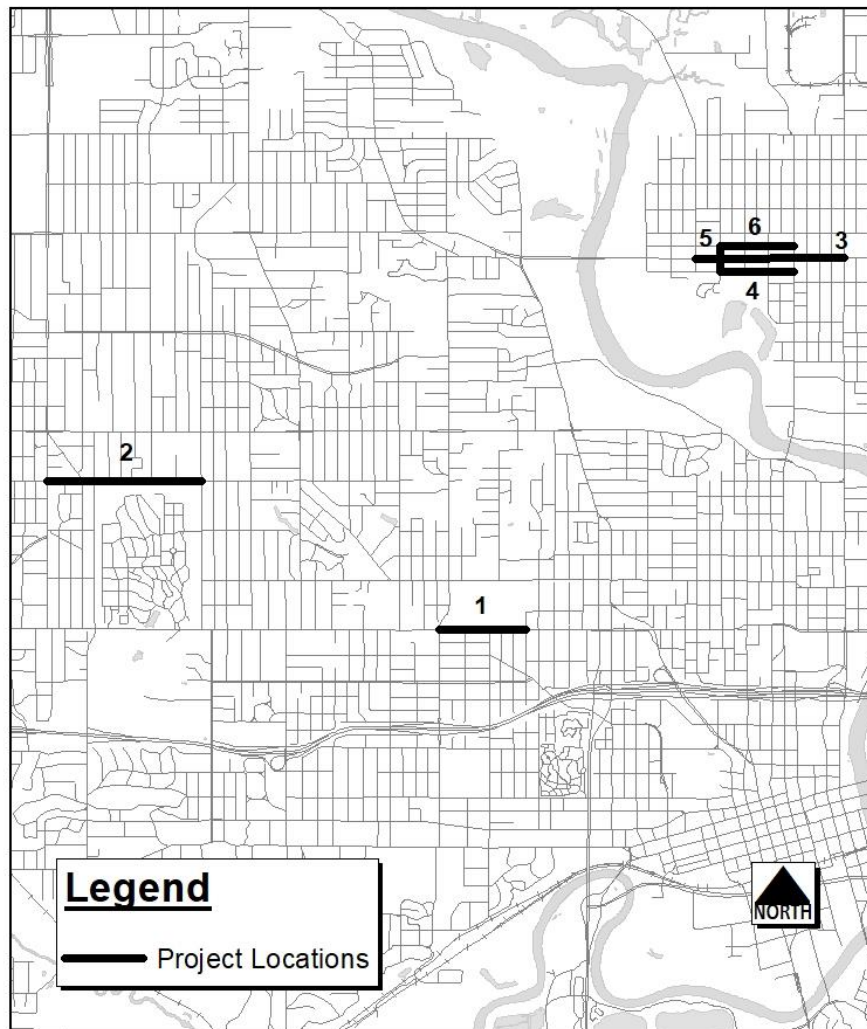
Amount: \$266,180 Construction Contract (\$265,000 City Engineer's Estimate).

Funding Source: 2022-23 CIP, Page 139, Euclid Roadway Reconfiguration 12th St to 2nd Ave, ST284, Being: \$97,710 G.O. Bonds and \$168,470 transferred from OP214.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

- On April 4, 2022, under Roll Call No. 22-0514, the City Council received and filed plans, specifications, form of contract documents, and City Engineer's estimate for the construction of the City-Wide Pavement Marking Program. Before the City Council can enter into a contract, it must hold a public hearing and approve the proposed plans, specifications, and form of contract documents and engineer's estimate for the construction of the City-Wide Pavement Marking Program, Activity ID 04-2022-018. The project will include installing pavement markings, traffic control and other incidental items; all in accordance with the contract documents, including Plan File No. 642-001/032 at the following locations:
 - University Avenue from 25th Street to 31st Street.

- Franklin Avenue from 48th Street to Merle Hay Road.
- Euclid Avenue from 2nd Ave to 12th Street.
- Oak Park Avenue from 6th Avenue to 11th Street.
- 11th Street from Oak Park Avenue to Clinton Avenue.
- Clinton Avenue from 6th Avenue to 11th Street.
- Sealed bids for said improvement were submitted by the following bidders:
 - Quality Striping, Inc., Des Moines, IA, Low Bid
 - Iowa Plains Signing, Inc., Slater, IA
- The bids were received and opened at a public meeting presided over by the City Engineer in the City Council Chambers, 2nd Floor, City Hall, 400 Robert D. Ray Drive, Des Moines, Iowa at 11:00 a.m. on April 19, 2022.
- The City Engineer has determined that the lowest responsive, responsible bid for the construction of said improvement was submitted by Quality Striping, Inc. (Jamie Jirak, President, 1704 E. Euclid Avenue, Des Moines, IA, 50313), in the amount of \$266,180, and said bid should be accepted. The Finance Director has determined that funds are available for said improvement as stated above.
