AGENDA HEADING:

Amending Chapter 60 regarding installation of carbon monoxide detectors.

SYNOPSIS:

HUD guidelines required carbon monoxide detectors to be installed as a requirement to subsidize rental units. This amendment brings the rental code into compliance with that requirement.

FISCAL IMPACT: NONE

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

- Carbon monoxide alarms are required in single-family rental units, single-family residences, and multiple-unit residential building if the building is served by a fuel-burning heater, fuelburning furnace, fuel-burning appliance, fuel-burning fireplace, or has an attached garage and must be installed immediately and no later than June 1, 2025. Installed per manufactures specifications.
- A carbon monoxide alarm shall be installed in the following locations:
 - Outside of each bedroom
 - o In every occupiable level of a dwelling, including basements
