

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

- The City's Neighborhood Sidewalk Program includes constructing new sidewalks to fill
 sidewalk gaps in the City. The initial priority for recommended improvements is along existing
 school recommended walk routes, proximity to schools, bus stops and commercial nodes,
 and/or providing connectivity for long segments of sidewalks.
- The 2023 Neighborhood Sidewalk Program public improvement project includes improvements at the following locations:
 - Shawnee Avenue from Beaver Avenue to 39th Place
 - o Euclid Avenue from Douglas Avenue to existing connection
 - o E. Shawnee Avenue from Columbia Street to Bowdoin Street
 - o E. Tiffin Avenue from North Union Street to E. 12th Street
 - o Franklin Avenue from crosswalk west of 49th Street to existing sidewalk
 - o College Avenue from 42nd Street to 41st Street
 - o 62nd Street from University Avenue to Clark Street
 - College Avenue from 13th Street to 10th Street
 - Clark Street from 9th Street to 8th Street

- o Cleveland Avenue from Pennsylvania Avenue to E. 9th Street
- o SE 2nd Street from South of E. Edison Avenue to E. Dunham Avenue
- o E. Edison Avenue from West of SE 2nd Street to SE 2nd Street
- o SE 5th Street from E. Livingston Avenue to E. Granger Avenue
- o SE 6th Street from Indianola Avenue to Pioneer Road
- o Watrous Avenue from SW 7th Street to South Union Street
- o Kenyon Avenue from SW 14th Street to SW 9th Street
- o Guthrie Avenue from Glenbrook Drive to west end of Viaduct
- o E. Douglas Avenue from Cornell Street to E. 9th Street
- A Request for Proposals (RFP) for professional services for 2022-2024 On-Call Sidewalk and Trail Design and Construction Phase Services was issued and posted on the City's website. A selection committee of Engineering Department staff reviewed and rated the 18 proposals received in response to the RFP. Kirkham Michael & Associates, Inc. was selected to provide services for this project based upon the selection criteria in the RFP and their thorough project approach, understanding, and related project experience.
- City staff has negotiated a PSA with Kirkham Michael & Associates, Inc. for a total cost not to exceed \$130,000, based on hourly rates, to provide Contract Management, Project Coordination, Survey and Data Collection, Preliminary Design, Design Phase Services and Bidding Phase Services to complete the improvements.
