AGENDA HEADING:

Approving and authorizing the procurement of repair service for all Storm and Sanitary Pump Stations from Electric Pump & Tool Services, Inc. (4280 E 14th Street, Des Moines, IA 50313, President, Tom Miller).

SYNOPSIS:

Electric Pump & Tool Services, Inc. is the only authorized manufacturer's representative within the metro area. Recommend approval of the procurement of pump repair services for all storm and sanitary pump stations from Electric Pump & Tool Services, Inc.

FISCAL IMPACT:

Amount: \$75,000

Funding Source: 2022-2023 Operating Budget, Page 207, Public Works Department, Sanitary Sewer Pump Station, E101 PW247412, Sanitary Sewer Operations Fund and Page 216, Public Works Department, Storm Pump Stations, E301 PW247414, Stormwater utility Operations Fund.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

- The City has 70 total pumping stations in operations. The storm pump stations provide flood protection during high water events. The sanitary pump stations convey sewage through force mains to the wastewater treatment plant.
- Electric Pump & Tool Service Inc. is the only authorized manufacturer's representative within the metro area. Electric Pump & Tool Service Inc. has provided the City with cost savings, reduction of inventory parts, and has helped to standardize pumps throughout the collection system.
