AGENDA HEADING:

Award bid to apply over 250,000 square yards (SY) of asphalt rejuvenation product to various asphalt streets within the City of Des Moines, with Corrective Asphalt Materials, LLC, Anthony J Witte, President, \$317,821.

SYNOPSIS:

Recommend approval of bid to apply asphalt rejuvenator to 253,200 square yards of full depth asphalt streets. This process will reduce future cracking and raveling of the asphalt, thereby extending the lifecycle of the street.

FISCAL IMPACT:

Amount: \$317,821

Funding Source: 2022-2023 Operating Budget, page 225, Public Works Department, Street Maintenance, S360 PW240402, Road Use Tax Fund.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

- In 2020, the Public Works Department contracted with Corrective Asphalt Materials to apply asphalt rejuvenator to 40,630 square yards of asphalt streets. The test results from this small project showed the application reduced the viscosity of the asphaltic cement in the pavement. This will lead to less cracking and less raveling over the lifecycle of the street. Less cracking and raveling will reduce potholes, essentially extending the useful life of the pavement.
- Five (5) potential bidders were identified, one (1) bid was received.
