AGENDA HEADING:

Approving Change Order No. 1 with Jasper Construction Services, Inc. for additional work on 2nd Avenue Bridge over Des Moines River Rehabilitation and 2nd Avenue Bridge over Birdland Drive Replacement, in the amount of \$156,341.16.

SYNOPSIS:

Recommend approval of Change Order No. 1 in an amount not to exceed \$156,341.16 with Jasper Construction Services, Inc. (Cliff Rhoads, President, 928 N 19th Avenue East, Newton, Iowa, 50208), for additional work on 2nd Avenue Bridge over Des Moines River Rehabilitation and 2nd Avenue Bridge over Birdland Drive Replacement.



<u>Funding Source</u>: 2022-2023 CIP, Page 26, 2nd Ave Bridge over the Des Moines River, BR057, Being: \$106,307.74 reimbursement from Des Moines Water Works (DMWW), remainder in G.O. Bonds.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

- On February 7, 2022, under Roll Call No. 22-201, the City Council held a hearing on the 2nd Avenue Bridge over the Des Moines River Rehabilitation and 2nd Avenue Bridge over Birdland Drive Replacement, and approved plans, specifications, form of contract documents, engineer's estimate, receive and file bids, and designating lowest responsible bidder as Jasper Construction Services, Inc., Cliff Rhoads, President, \$9,983,440.85.
- The Des Moines River bridge rehabilitation includes new bridge expansion joints, full removal and replacement of concrete barrier rails, new barrier rail steel railing, new exterior ornamental railing, full blast cleaning and repainting of the bridge beams, and railing and pier accent lighting. The Birdland Drive bridge replacement includes removal of the existing concrete bridge, construction of a new continuous Portland Cement Concrete (PCC) slab bridge on steel pile foundations, structural concrete, epoxy reinforcing steel, longitudinal grooving, new PCC bridge barrier rail, new barrier rail steel railing, new exterior ornamental railing, PCC slope paving, and railing accent lighting. The bridge replacement also includes construction of new bridge PCC approach pavement, PCC sidewalk construction, PCC trail construction along Birdland Drive, traffic control, pavement markings, seeding and erosion control items, and mobilization.

During construction, an existing 20-inch diameter water main broke behind the existing bridge abutment causing complete loss of the abutment backfill, damaging existing pavement and sidewalks, and eroding around the northwest bridge wing and damaging the abutment slope. Des Moines Water Works completed the water main repair but requested the assistance of the contractor for necessary removals for the repair and requested the contractor complete the repairs caused by the water main break. Change Order No. 1 includes this repair work by the contractor and will be reimbursed by Des Moines Water Works. Change Order No. 1 also adds trail protection system to allow Neal Smith Trail to remain open during construction, adds river caution signage, adds a storm sewer connection, adds railing galvanizing plugs, and adds erosion control measures for intakes.
