#### **AGENDA HEADING:**

Hearing on 2022 HMA Resurfacing Program Contract 1: Resolution approving plans, specifications, form of contract documents, engineer's estimate, receive and file bids, and designating lowest responsible bidder as OMG Midwest, Inc. d/b/a Des Moines Asphalt & Paving, Kevin Bragg, President, \$1,489,296.25.

### **SYNOPSIS:**

This is a public hearing to allow for public input on the 2022 HMA Resurfacing Program Contract 1 and take the necessary actions as required by Iowa Code to authorize a contract for construction of the proposed project. This project provides for full-depth patching and resurfacing of roadways utilizing surface scarification and Hot Mix Asphalt (HMA) overlay to improve the surface condition and to extend the useful service life of the streets.

### **FISCAL IMPACT:**

Amount: \$1,489,296.25 Construction Contract (\$1,500,000 City Engineer's Estimate).



## ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

- On July 18, 2022, under Roll Call No. 22-1114, the City Council received and filed plans, specifications, form of contract documents, and City Engineer's estimate for the construction of the 2022 HMA Resurfacing Program Contract 1. Before the City Council can enter into a contract, it must hold a public hearing and approve the proposed plans, specifications, and form of contract documents and engineer's estimate for the construction of the 2022 HMA Resurfacing Program Contract 1, Activity ID 06-2021-011. The improvement includes scarification of existing asphalt streets, furnish and place HMA, furnish and place pavement markings, Traffic control, and other incidental items; all in accordance with the contract documents, including Plan File No. 643-221/257, at the following locations in Des Moines, Iowa, and as illustrated in the figure below:
  - o Amos Avenue SW 9th Street to SW 14th Street
  - o Porter Avenue SW 9th Street to Fleur Drive
  - o Kirkwood Avenue South Union Street to SW 9th Street
  - o 17th Street Woodland Avenue to Crocker Street

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- o Franklin Avenue 34th Street to Beaver Avenue
- o Hull Avenue Cornell Street to E 14th Street
- o Arthur Avenue E 14th Street to Glenbrook Drive
- Sealed bids for said improvement were submitted by the following bidders:
  - OMG Midwest, Inc. d/b/a Des Moines Asphalt & Paving, Ankeny, IA, Low Bid
  - o InRoads, LLC, Des Moines, IA
  - o Grimes Asphalt and Paving Corporation, Des Moines, IA
- The bids were received and opened at a public meeting presided over by the City Engineer in the City Council Chambers, 2nd Floor, City Hall, 400 Robert D. Ray Drive, Des Moines, Iowa at 11:00 a.m. on August 9, 2022.
- The City Engineer has determined that the lowest responsive, responsible bid for the construction of said improvement was submitted by OMG Midwest, Inc. (d/b/a Des Moines Asphalt & Paving, Kevin Bragg, President, 2401 SE Tones Drive, Suite 13, Ankeny, IA, 50021), in the amount of \$1,489,296.25, and recommends said bid should be accepted. The Finance Director has determined that funds are available for said improvement as stated above.
