

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

- In 2021, the City, with its consultant, completed a Sanitary Sewer Planning Prioritization Study to develop a guide in prioritizing new sanitary sewer projects to serve current unsewered and under-sewered areas suitable for development or areas currently served by individual septic systems.
- The Sanitary Sewer Planning Prioritization Study identified the area around S.W. 14th Street, Tuttle Street, Gray's Parkway, and S.W. 11th Street as needing additional sewer capacity due to the area being underserved and under redevelopment.
- To provide the necessary sewer service to the area, the Gray's Station Sanitary Trunk Sewer project will extend sanitary sewer from the Riverpoint West Pump Station near the intersection of S.W. 11th Street and Dart Way westerly and northerly to the area of S.W. 16th Street and Tuttle Street.
- Construction of the project is scheduled to begin in the spring of 2023. The property interests need for this project will be determined after design is completed.
