#### AGENDA HEADING:

Approving Change Order No. 1 with OMG Midwest, Inc. d/b/a Des Moines Asphalt & Paving for additional work on 2022 HMA Resurfacing Program Contract 1, in the amount of \$217,157.37.

### **SYNOPSIS:**

Recommend approval of Change Order No. 1 in an amount not to exceed \$217,157.37 with Des Moines Asphalt & Paving (Kevin Bragg, President, 2401 SE Tones Drive, Suite 13, Ankeny, Iowa, 50021), for additional work on 2022 HMA Resurfacing Program Contract 1.


Amount: \$217,157.37

<u>Funding Source</u>: 2022-2023 CIP, Page 116, Roadway Rehabilitation – Collector, ST217, Being: \$7,127.37 Gaming Monies, and \$210,000 transferred from ST276 Ingersoll Streetscape.

## ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

- On August 22, 2022, under Roll Call Number 22-1357, the City Council held a public hearing and approved plans and specifications for the 2022 HMA Resurfacing Program Contract 1, and designated the lowest responsible bidder as Des Moines Asphalt & Paving for \$1,489,296.25.
- The improvement includes scarification of existing asphalt streets, furnish and place Hot Mix Asphalt (HMA), furnish and place pavement markings, traffic control, and other incidental items at the following locations, and as illustrated in the figure below:
  - o Amos Avenue SW 9<sup>th</sup> Street to SW 14<sup>th</sup> Street
  - o Porter Avenue SW 9<sup>th</sup> Street to Fleur Drive
  - o Kirkwood Avenue South Union Street to SW 9<sup>th</sup> Street
  - o 17<sup>th</sup> Street Woodland Avenue to Crocker Street
  - o Franklin Avenue 34<sup>th</sup> Street to Beaver Avenue
  - o Hull Avenue Cornell Street to E. 14<sup>th</sup> Street
  - o Arthur Avenue E. 14<sup>th</sup> Street to Glenbrook Drive
- This change order includes adding items for resurfacing the eastbound lanes on Ingersoll Avenue from 35<sup>th</sup> Street to 42<sup>nd</sup> Street. As part of the Western Ingersoll Run Sewer Separation Phase 1 project, the westbound lanes of Ingersoll Avenue have been reconstructed/resurfaced.

While the sewer separation project has been under construction, the eastbound lane and parking lane have been used to maintain traffic in each direction. The additional volume of traffic on these lanes has accelerated deterioration of the existing pavement.
